



F-86D SABREDOGS

A/C Type	F-86D-30-NA
Pilot & Unit	Maj. Turner, 97th FIS
Locale & Date	Wright-Patterson AFB, 1953
Camouflage & Markings	Natural metal finish overall with various gray panels. Olive Drab anti-glare panel, Semi- gloss Black radome.

After painting fuselage and airbrakes, place the opening section of the airbrake over the cavity. It will stay in place. Then apply the fuselage insignia over it. With a NEW # 11 knife, trim around the airbrake. Separate them. Apply SOL solution to both edges to smooth out any left overs. This is the best way we have found to go around these features.

Notice fin tips on all these A/C are Lt. Gray, in a specific pattern, not just the fin cap.

Notice little Black strips to trim the chute housing.
