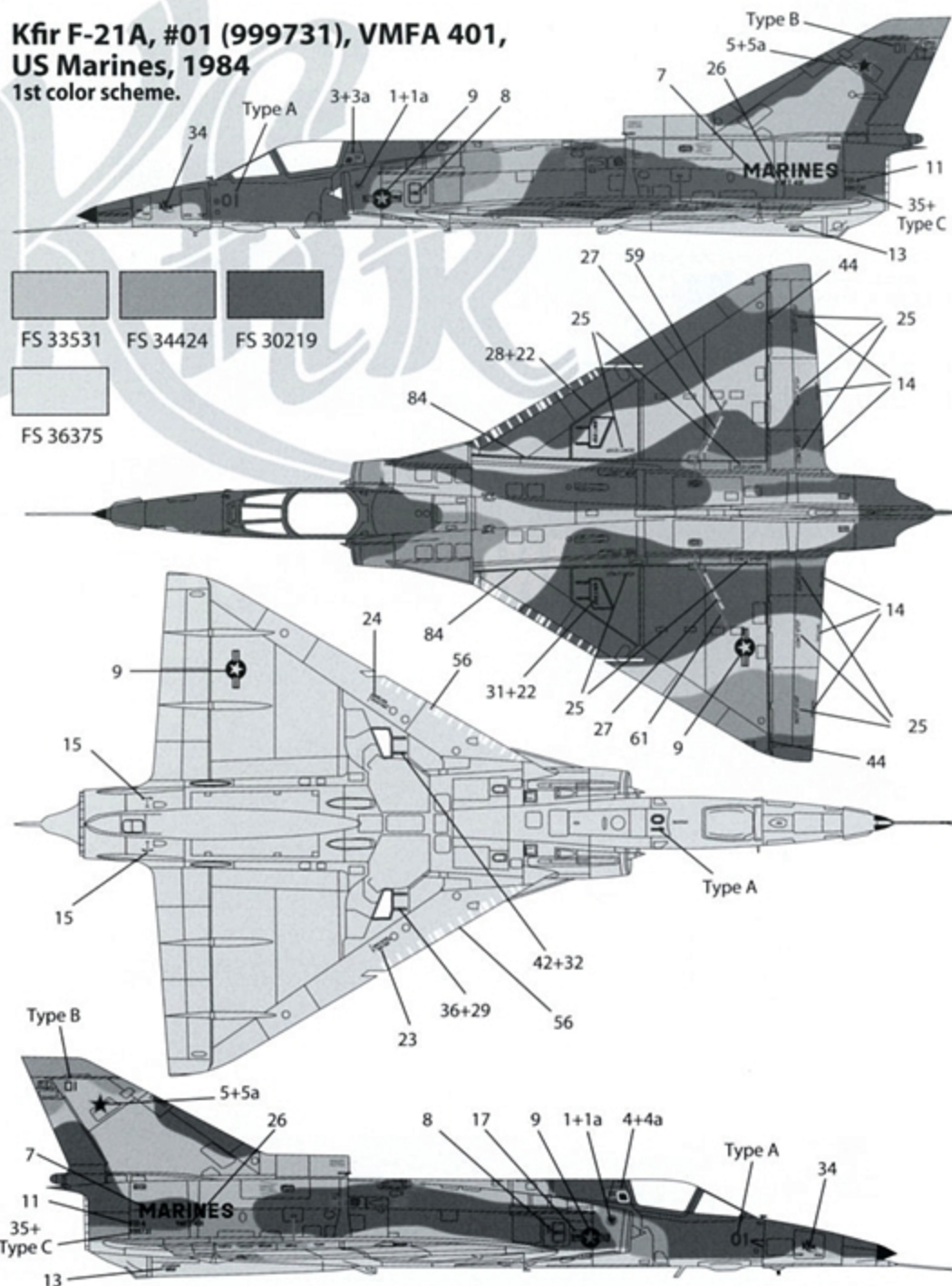

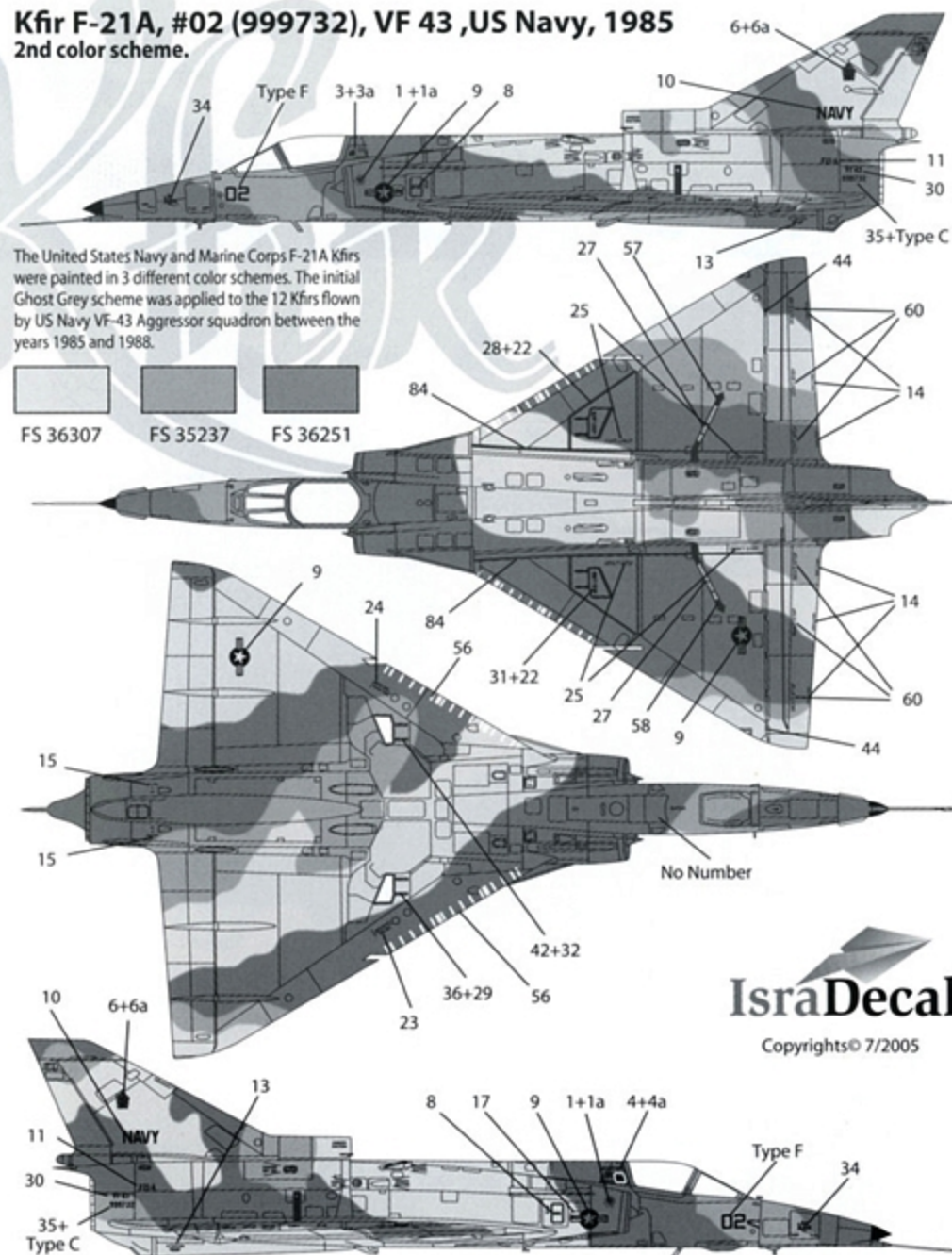
**Kfir F-21A, #01 (999731), VMFA 401,

The USMC operated 13 F-21A Kfirs in three different color schemes. The Ghost Gray scheme identical to that used by the Navy; An Israeli Kfir C7 type camouflage using F-16 desert scheme colors; and a third color scheme similar to the F-5E Lizard scheme. US Navy and Marine Kfirs were identified with a two digit number applied to the nose gear door, and a six digit number beginning with 999 and ending with the last three digits of the a/c number

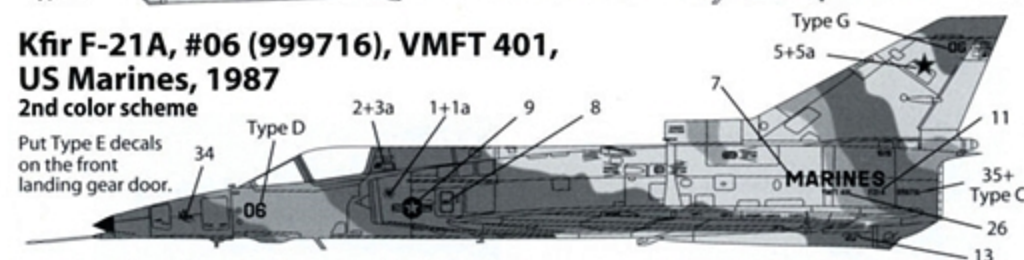
as it was applied when in service with the Israeli Air Force. The US Marine VMFA 401 Aggressor squadron operated the F-21A between the years 1987 and 1989. Most USMC Kfirs camouflaged with the IAF C7 or Lizard camouflage scheme, had red ID numbers applied to the forward nose gear door.

2nd color scheme.**



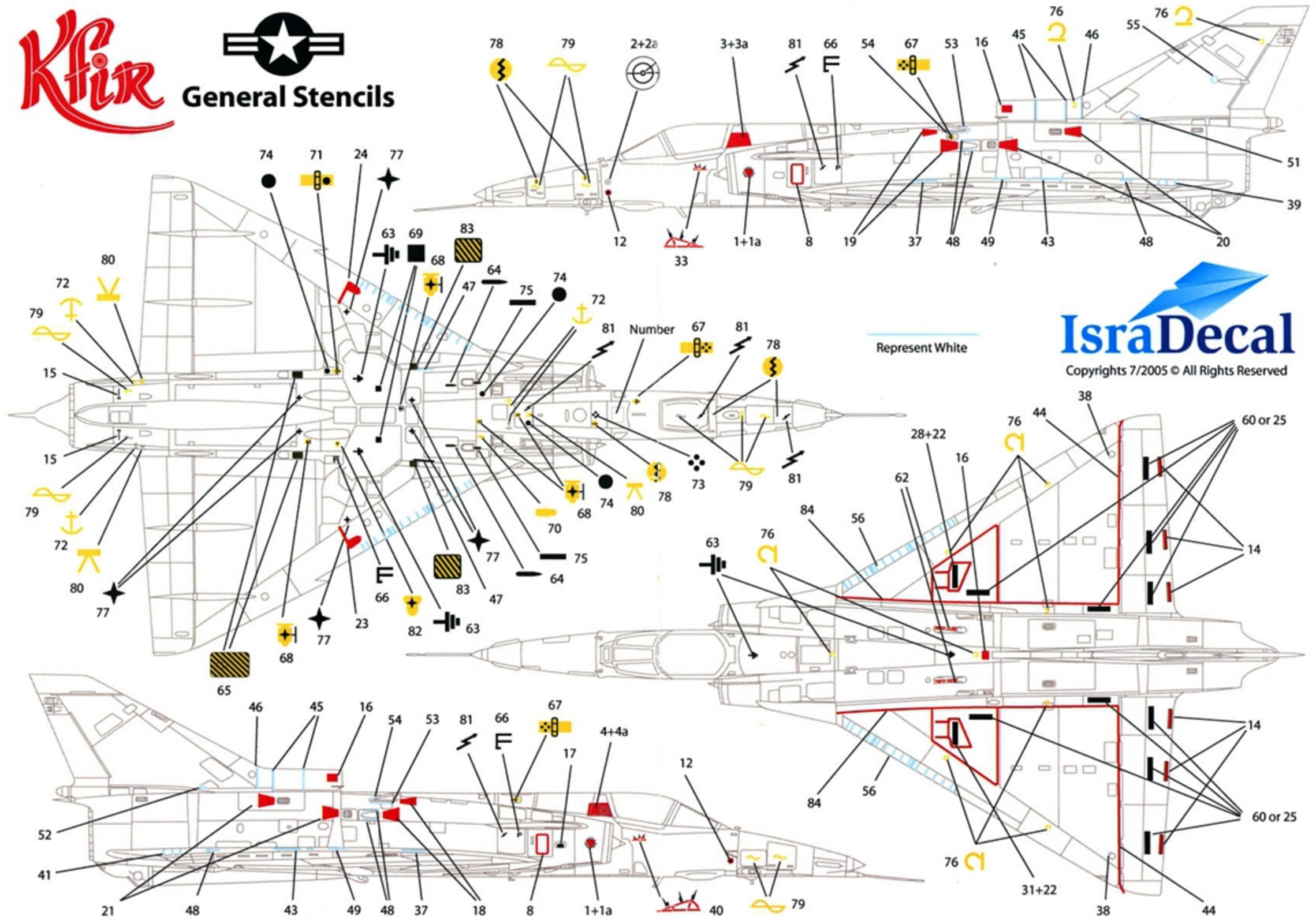
The United States Navy and Marine Corps F-21A Kfirs were painted in 3 different color schemes. The initial Ghost Gray scheme was applied to the 12 Kfirs flown by US Navy VF-43 Aggressor squadron between the years 1985 and 1988.
