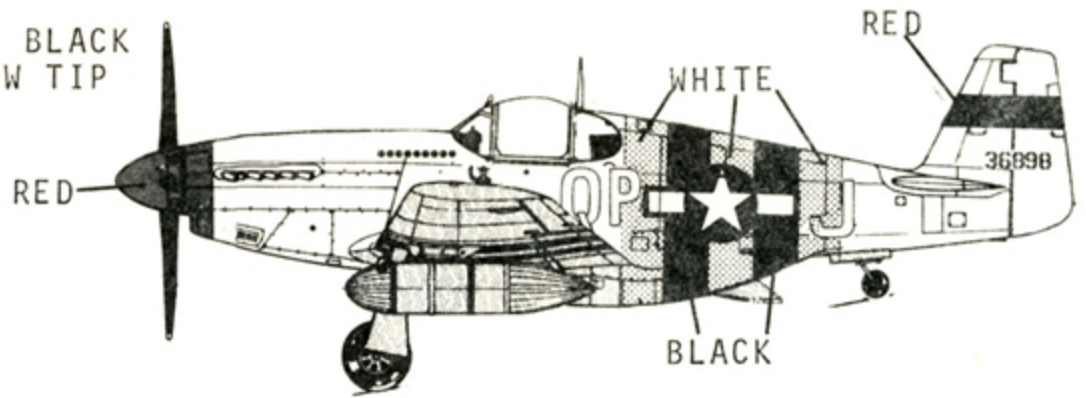
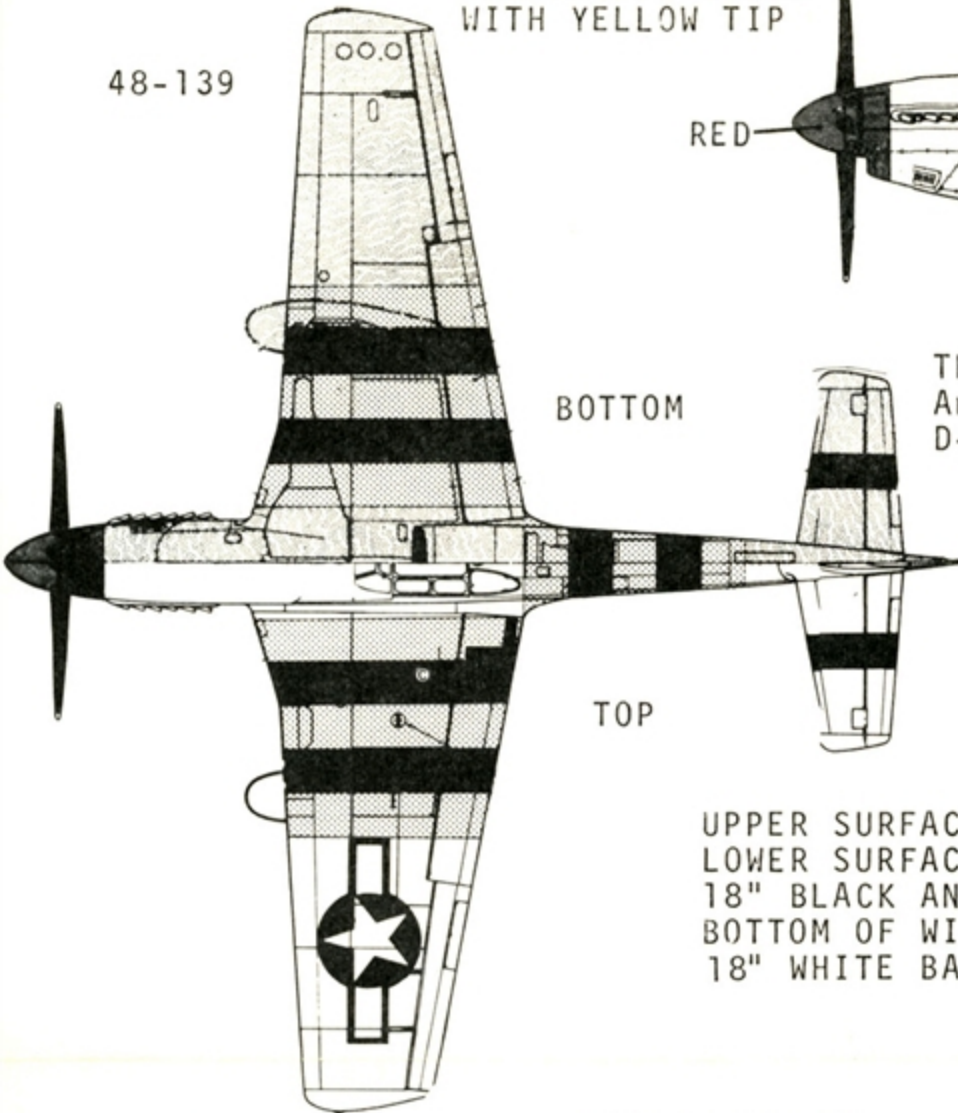

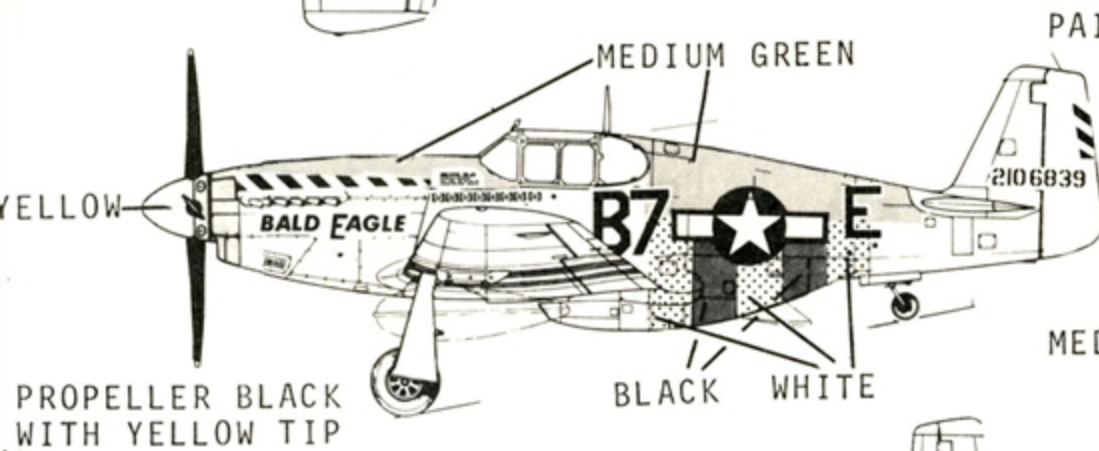

D-Day June 6 1944.

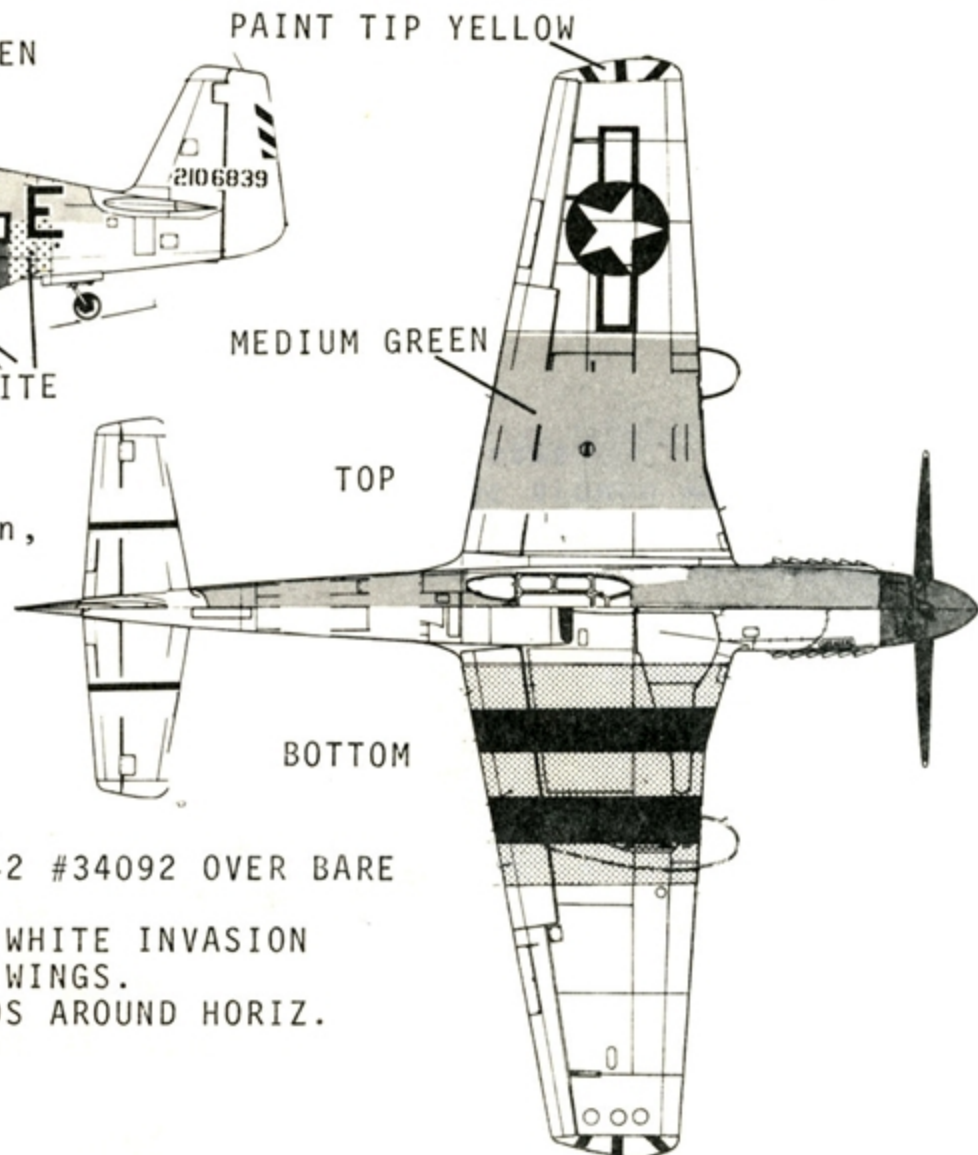

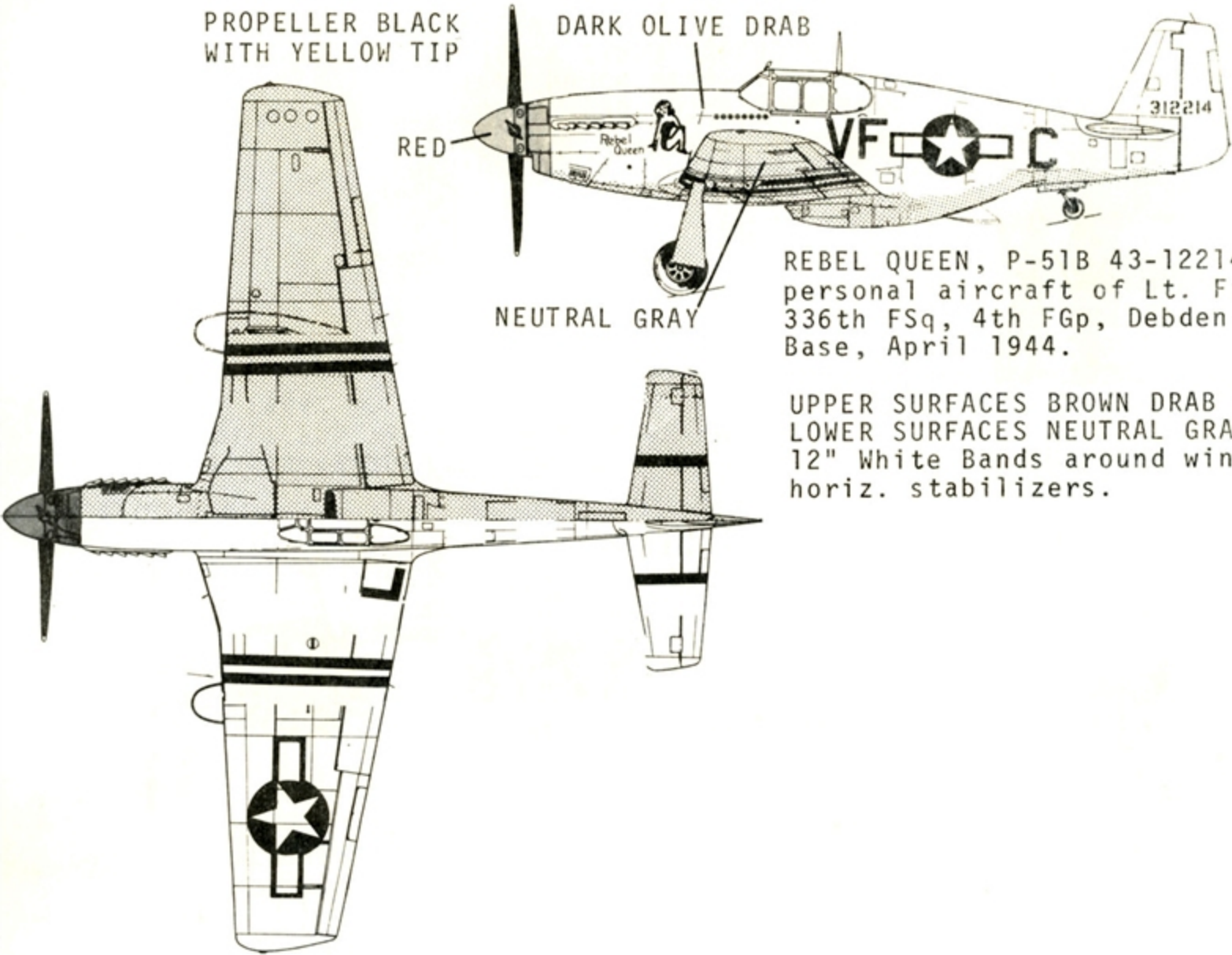

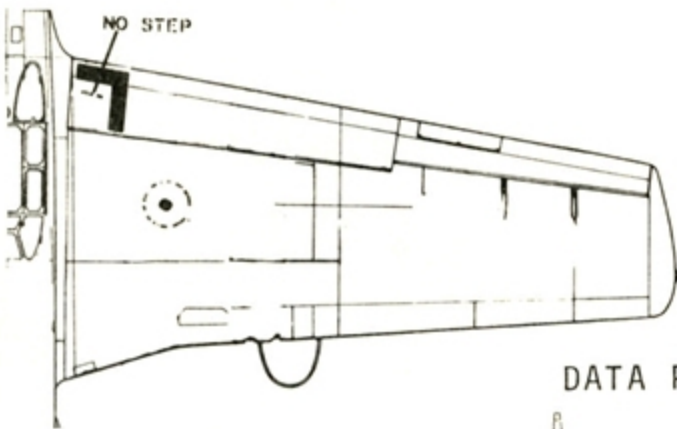
