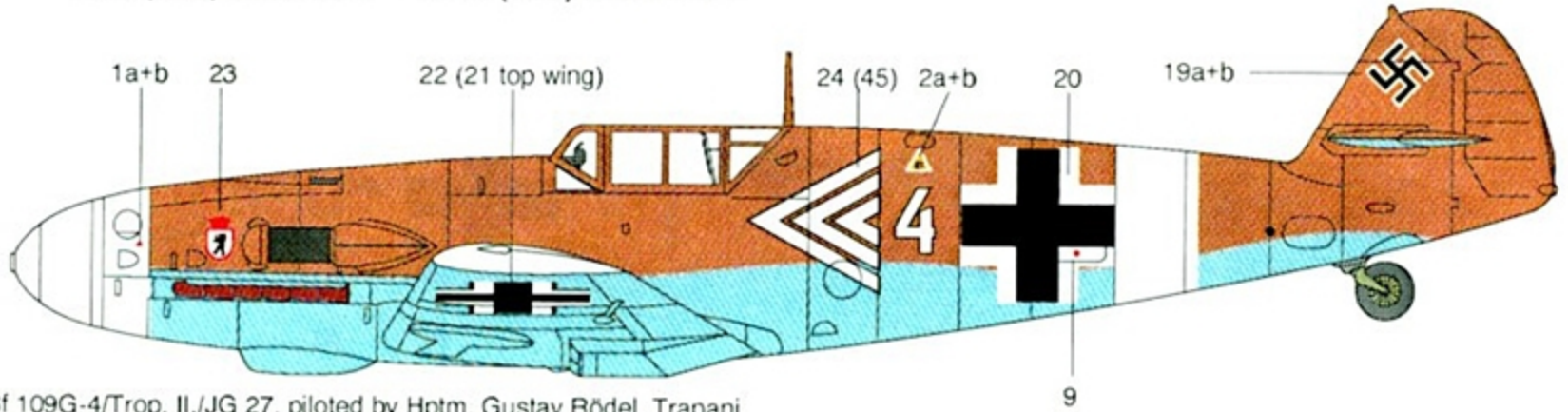


Mediterranean Bf 109s of JG 27



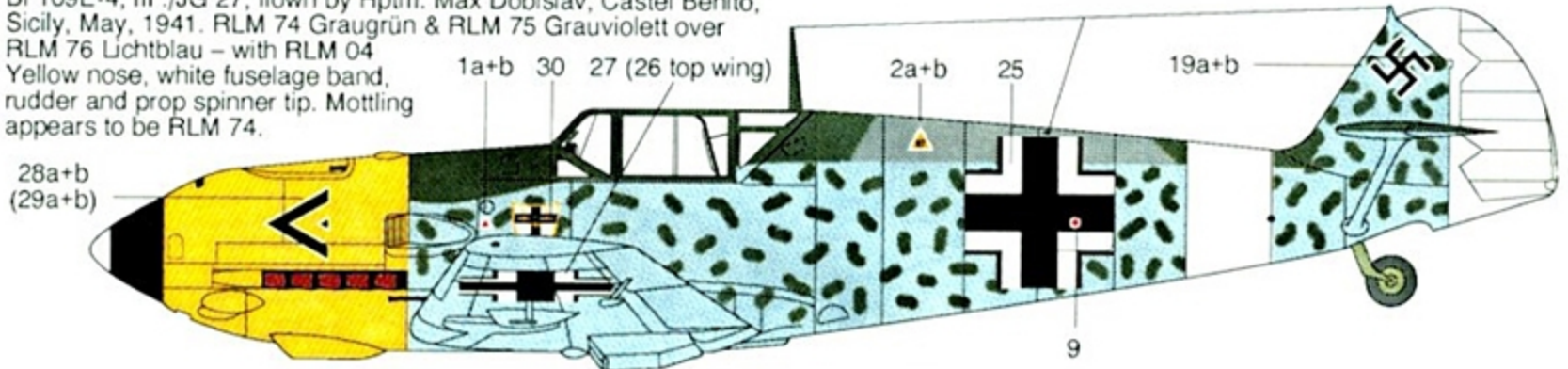

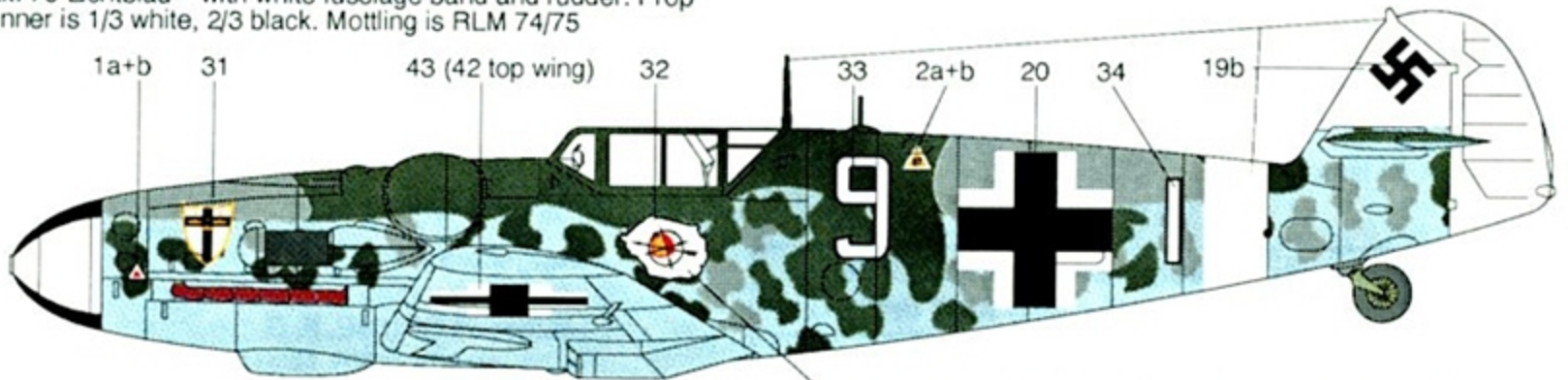

Bf 109E-4, III./JG 27, flown by Hptm. Max Dobislav, Castel Benito, Sicily, May, 1941. RLM 74 Graugrün & RLM 75 Grauviolett over RLM 76 Lichtblau – with RLM 04 Yellow nose, white fuselage band, rudder and prop spinner tip. Mottling appears to be RLM 74.

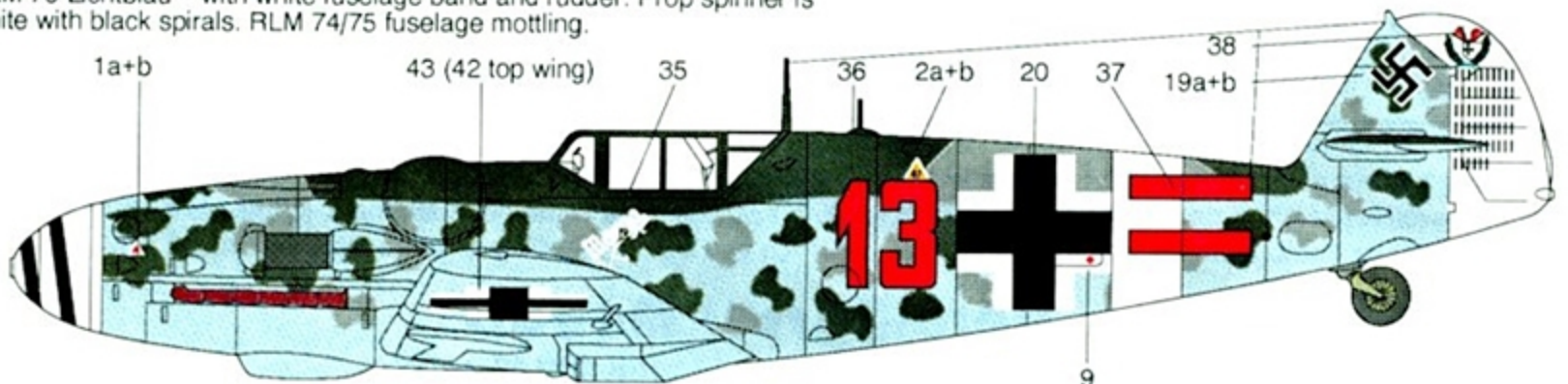


Bf 109G-6/Trop, 7./JG 27, piloted by Obl. Emil Klade, Kalamaki, Greece, Jan., 1944. RLM 74 Graugrün & RLM 75 Grauviolett over RLM 76 Lichtblau – with white fuselage band and rudder. Prop spinner is 1/3 white, 2/3 black. Mottling is RLM 74/75



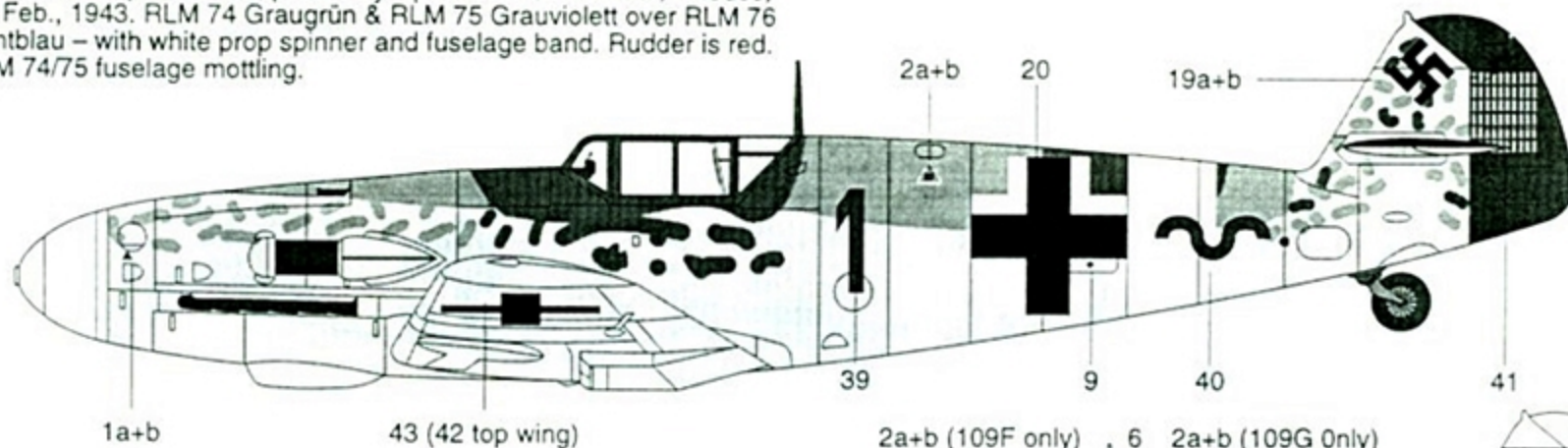
(note: an additional 32 is supplied for the starboard side, although some experts doubt that Klade's aircraft carried this marking there.)

Bf 109G-6/R6, 11./JG 27, piloted by Fwbl. Heinrich Bartels, Kalamaki, Greece, ca. Sept., 1943. RLM 74 Graugrün & RLM 75 Grauviolett over RLM 76 Lichtblau – with white fuselage band and rudder. Prop spinner is white with black spirals. RLM 74/75 fuselage mottling.

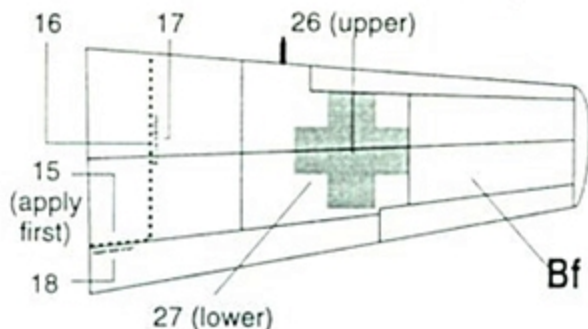
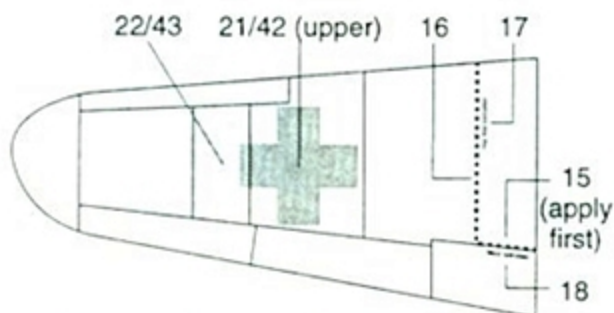
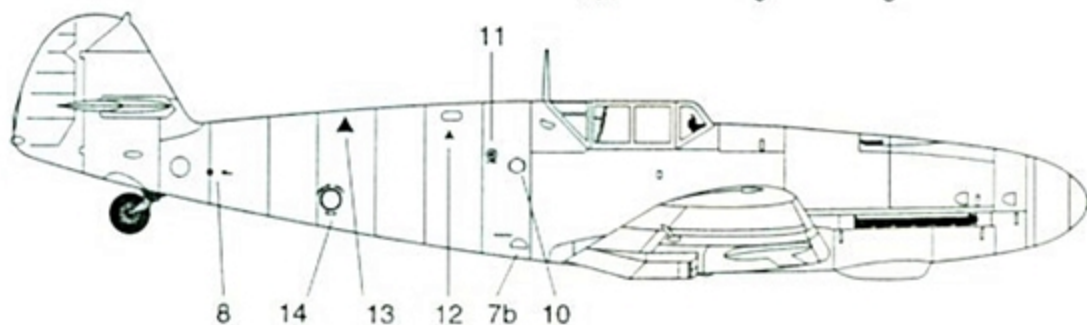
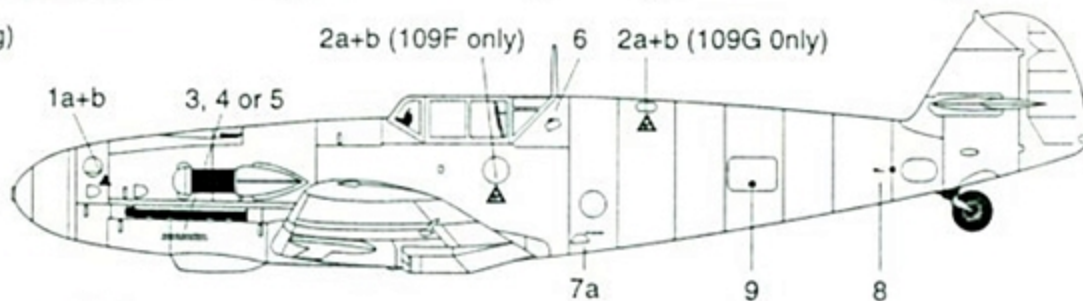
